As part of Casey's role, she has to be flexible, so completing an apprenticeship course is perfect for her, as it means she can swap the days in which she works at The Willows and the time she spends studying course material.

When asked what her motivation was to take on an apprenticeship course, Casey said, "Mainly for personal development. I wanted to progress further in my role and gain more knowledge - this course has been amazing for that. It fits perfectly around my schedule and has taught me lots of things I can put into practice in my working role."



Casey is due to complete her apprenticeship course in November 2022, qualifying her as Level 2 Team Leader. She doesn't plan to stop her development there though. Casey said she wants to complete a Level 3 in Adult Care, to further progress in her career in caring.
